When the judge's results at the 2011 Langhorne Creek Wine Showcase were announced last Friday 6th of May it was soon evident that the best place to experience the cream of the Langhorne Creek crop is The Winehouse.

The Winehouse is a unique collective tasting room that showcases five of Langhorne Creek's leading labels and is now home to 50% of the trophies awarded at the 2011 Langhorne Creek Showcase.

The tasting room is home to Ben Potts Wines by sixth generation Langhorne Creek winemaker Ben Potts, Gipsie Jack Wine Company by John Glaetzer and Ben Potts, John's Blend by industry stalwart and winner of four Jimmy Watson trophies John Glaetzer, Kimbolton Wines by the Case family – a small local family owned and operated wine producer and Heartland Wines by Ben Glaetzer.

Of the six trophies on offer at the Showcase brands that call The Winehouse home took out three.

The winners were:

Best Alternate Variety/Other Reds
Gipsie Jack 2006 Malbec rrp \$22

Best Cabernet Sauvignon
Kimbolton 2009 Fig Tree Cabernet Sauvignon rrp \$24

Best Shiraz
Ben Potts 2007 Shiraz rrp \$40.

The success at the Showcase underlines what brought these producers under the one roof in the first place - a deep and abiding love for Langhorne Creek and an unwavering commitment to show the world the region at its best.

Anytime is a good time to visit The Winehouse, Wellington Road, Langhorne Creek but now particularly so with both the Gipsie Jack Malbec and Kimbolton Cabernet Sauvignon trophy winners available for tasting and sale.
